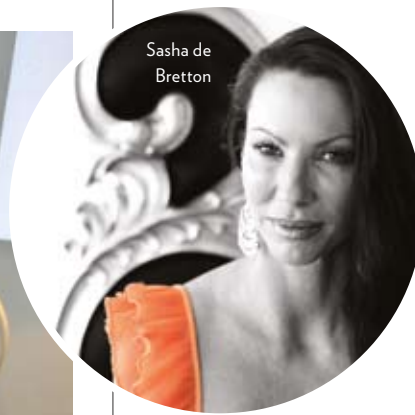


COME FLY WITH ME

Million Dollar Makeovers owner Sasha de Bretton made the cut in this year's *40 Under 40*, which recognises outstanding young businesspeople. It's one of just several awards carried off since she set up the company in 2009. The self-confessed serial renovator started young then bought and renovated properties for 17 years before turning her hobby into a business that does lightning-fast makeovers aimed at increasing a home's value.

Sasha says her company can complete an average renovation within 14 days, a lot faster than the average DIY job, which can take months or even years, wasting money along the way.

Her company's approach can save clients thousands of dollars, sometimes hundreds of thousands, she adds. The guiding principle revolves around an inflexible plan of attack drawn up by the all-female staff.

"There is nothing more dangerous than a woman with a plan," Sasha says with a laugh.

"We run a tight ship, where everyone knows their job and how to do it within the timeframe." They have a terrific relationship with their tradespeople, she adds.

The results can be spectacular, aesthetically and financially. A recent renovation increased a three-storey home's value by \$1 million, she says. An average one can net owners a \$250,000 profit. She may be a qualified builder, but Sasha and her team are also known for their interior design expertise, creating that unmistakable 'wow' factor. "We save you time, stress, mess, headaches... and divorce," Sasha says.
